Notice is hereby given as required by Title 5, Chapter 551.041 of the Government Code that the Argyle Crime Control and Prevention District will meet in a Special Meeting May 15, 2020 at 5:30 PM via Zoom conference call. The Items listed below are placed on the agenda for discussion and/or action.

C. OPEN FORUM

The opportunity for citizens to address the Argyle Crime Control and Prevention District on any non-agenda item (limit 5 minutes per person); however, the Texas Open Meetings Act prohibits the Argyle Crime Control and Prevention District from discussing issues which the public has not been given seventy-two (72) hour notice. Issues raised may be referred to Town Staff for research and possible future action.

D. NEW BUSINESS

1. Funding Requests – see APD CCPD budget requests.
 - a. Tablets and data plan for sergeants, chief and CID investigator. Four Verizon tablets and an unlimited data plan would allow the above staff to work anywhere with a secure encrypted connection. Currently, the staff may only access County applications and the PD network from their mobile in vehicle computers, which are mounted in the vehicle. Work can not be done on scene or from a remote location. Budget reallocation from account 6223 for \$1759.80 for the five months left in the fiscal year would be in place of the originally budgeted Tasers for \$4500.
 - b. Vehicle. This would be a budget amendment and must go to Town Council for ratification. The funds (\$31691.64) must come from the CCPD fund balance. This is an unbudgeted expense, due to a FY19 vehicle payment being made in FY20, essentially absorbing the intent to purchase a vehicle in FY20. However, the PD must purchase a vehicle in this FY to avoid the need to purchase three (3) vehicles in a future FY. As a matter of protocol, high mileage vehicles that are still operable and economically maintainable will be reassigned to the Chief or CID. The requested amount is a portion of the full amount of the vehicle and related equipment purchase, as other budgeted amounts have been reallocated to this item. The full amount of the vehicle and related equipment is approximately \$62200.
