



**Town Council
Special Meeting
Minutes – June 19, 2019**

The Special Meeting of the Town Council was held on **June 19, 2019** at 5:15 p.m. at the Argyle Town Hall. This was an OPEN MEETING, open to the public, subject to the open meeting laws of the State of Texas and, as required by law, was duly posted, at Argyle Town Hall, giving notice of time, date, place, and agenda thereof.

A. EXECUTIVE SESSION

1. Mayor Donald Moser called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. and convened in to Executive Session.

2. At 5:15 p.m. the Town Council adjourned into executive session PURSUANT TO TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, ANNOTATED, CHAPTER 551, SUBCHAPTER D:
 - a. Personnel matters pursuant to Section 551.074 (to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee): Councilmember Place 2
3. Adjourn into Open Meeting at 8:27 p.m.
4. Consider action on executive session items.

Mayor Moser asked Town Attorney to state the options the Council has regarding the Executive Session item. Mr. Hager informed Council they have four options as a result of the complaint against Councilmember Place 2 being 1) Council may choose not to take action pursuant to Argyle Code of Ordinance Section 1.06.008 (c); 2) Council may ask the Town Attorney to conduct a more extensive investigation into the complaint pursuant to Argyle Code of Ordinance 1.06.006; 3) Council may establish there was a violation and conduct a full trial over the matter including the interviewing of additional witnesses; 4)

Council may choose to establish there was a violation and impose sanctions on the Councilmember.

APPROVED

Councilmember Vukasin moved to find that Councilmember Place 2 conduct on April 23, 2019 at the Regular Meeting of the Argyle Town Council to be in violation of Section 1.06.003 (b) (13) of the Code of Ordinances; and the following sanctions shall be imposed effective immediately:


- a. Councilmember Place 2 may not attend Council Meetings or Proceedings of the Town of Argyle until September 15, 2019;
- b. Councilmember Place 2 shall submit a public apology in writing to be delivered to the Mayor on or before June 25th and read into the record of the next regular council meeting;
- c. Councilmember Place 2 shall be removed from Mayor Pro Tem.


