# **MINUTES**

### **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Livingston called the regular meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. with the following council members present:

#### STAFF REPORT

#### **Community Representative**

1. Presentation from Brandon Board with the Community Storehouse

Mr. Brandon Board provided an overview to the Council on the purpose and background of the Community Storehouse and the assistance they provide the Argyle Independent School District.

#### **Town Administrator**

2. Presentation and discussion on the current status of the Town of Argyle Strategic Plan.

Mr. Olson provided a brief overview of the current status of the strategic plan. Councilmembers expressed their appreciation for the work done by Staff to handle assigned tasks.

3. Presentation and discussion on qualification submittals received for Town Engineer.

Mr. Olson informed Council the Town received three submittals for Town Engineer, with two of those being firms the Town has dealt with in the past. Mayor Livingston advised he would like the firms to provide a presentation to Council prior to action being taken on choosing a new town engineer. Mr. Olson stated his goal was to have a firm in place by September 1st.

4. Presentation and discussion on the Town hosting an annual 4th of July event.

Mr. Olson stated he has been asked to task the new position of Communications Coordinator to create an annual Town event such as a 4th of July fest. Councilmembers suggested a different time of year since many other neighboring cities already celebrate the 4th of July. Mayor Livingston suggested creating a special events committee comprised of residents and Staff that can bring forth ideas to the Council on events they feel will benefit the Town and provide an enhanced sense of community.

#### **Communications Coordinator**

Mrs. Julia Falcon, Communications Coordinator, provided an update to Council on work she is doing to relaunch the Argyle Business Association through meetings, social media updates, and research. Mrs. Falcon has met with the Municipal Development District to gather feedback on their priorities for the upcoming year and create a shop local campaign and events. The goal is to spread awareness of businesses in the Town and the ETJ, including home-based businesses.

#### **WORKSHOP ITEMS**

9. Discussion on findings from a facility study.

Mr. Olson and a representative from Freese and Nicholas provided an update to Council on the facility study that was conducted. The study analyzed the current use of Town Hall and the Police Department and made recommended needs moving forward with the projected staff numbers. Mayor Livingston suggested Staff get an official appraisal of the police department building and provide that information to Council at a later date. Councilmember suggested looking at the possibility of moving the police department to Town Hall with necessary renovations or possibly look at using the Public Works facility for a relocation of the police department.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS**

10. Hold a public hearing to consider and take appropriate action on Ordinance 2021-16 to amending the Town Development Standards by approving an ordinance amendment (TDS-21-005) to Article III, Zoning, of the Town of Argyle Town Development Standards regarding various amendments to solar energy system requirements and other alternative energy system regulations in the Town Development Standards.

The public hearing was open and closed at 8:05 p.m. with no comments from the public made.

Council instructed staff to work with the Town Attorney to make suggested changes to the ordinance and bring it back for approval at the next regular meeting.

Motion to table the item until the August 2nd regular council meeting made by Mayor Pro Tem Schmidt, Seconded by Councilmember Myers.

11. Discuss and consider appropriate action on a Site Plan (SP-21-003) for the Avalon Amenity Center, being 0.786 acres situated in the F.W. Thorton Survey, Abstract No. 1244, Denton County, Texas; being located in Avalon at Argyle Phase One, Lot 1X, Block D; located in the Town of Argyle south of FM 407 and east of IH-35W.

12. Discuss and consider appropriate action on a variance request to Section 8.02.003.C.6.B Noise of the Code of ordinances of the Town of Argyle for concrete pouring related to the Well Community Church project.

14. Discuss and consider approval of Resolution 2021-36 with recommended amendments to the board appointment policy approved by Resolution 2021-28.

Councilmember Schmidt suggested in the section pertaining to Mid-Term Appointments be amended to state applications for vacancies will be accepted for a minimum of two weeks. This amendment would allow for the application process to be extended if qualifying applications have not been received during the minimum two-week period. The same correction was requested to be made to the Filling of Vacancy - Council Member section.

In both sections will be amended to state the Council will interview applicants in closed session at the next available Town Council meeting.

Motion to approve the resolution with recommended changes made by Mayor Pro Tem Schmidt, Seconded by Councilmember Myers.

15. Discuss and consider approval of the purchase of a cloud-based sales tax analytic platform through ZacTax.
