ARGYLE, TX (April 19, 2022) – During the Town Council meeting on Monday, April 18, 2022, the Town Council appointed Laura Calcote as town secretary/assistant town administrator. Evans Tract Approval

A revised site plan for the Evans Tract, located on FM 407 in front of BPS Technology, was approved Monday evening. This site plan was also approved by the Planning & Zoning Commission during their April 6 meeting. The original site plan called for a drive-thru and an atrium, which have been removed from the revised site plan. The new site plan is a two-story 19,673 sq. ft. facility with office, restaurant and retail uses with sidewalks and more outdoor spaces.
